



Restrictions on Dangerous Goods

Dangerous goods must not be carried in checked or carry-on baggage, except as otherwise allowed below.

EXPLOSIVES

Item	Carry-on	Checked
Fireworks	✗	✗
Flares	✗	✗

FLAMMABLE SUBSTANCES

Item	Carry-on	Checked
Alcoholic beverages* in retail packagings containing no more than 70% alcohol by volume, total quantity must not exceed 5 L	✓	✓
Toilet articles* including aerosols such as hair sprays, perfumes and colognes, total quantity of these articles must not exceed 2 L and net quantity of each single article must not exceed 0.5 L	✓	✓
Fuels including cooking fuels and any flammable liquid fuel	✗	✗
Gasoline	✗	✗
Lighter refills	✗	✗
Lighter only one is allowed when carried on the person	✗	✗
Flammable paints	✗	✗
Paint thinner	✗	✗

BATTERIES

Item	Carry-on	Checked
Lithium ion battery powered equipment containing batteries over 100 Wh but not exceeding 160 Wh	✓	✓

Item (cont.)	Carry-on	Checked
Spare lithium ion batteries up to 2 with individual protection to prevent short circuits and each over 100 Wh but not exceeding 160 Wh	✓	✗
Portable electronic devices containing lithium batteries such as cameras, smart phones, lap-top computers, tablets, etc., for personal use	✓	✓
Spare lithium batteries for portable electronic devices must be individually protected to prevent short circuits	✓	✗
Battery-powered wheelchairs	✗	✓

OTHER DANGEROUS GOODS

Item	Carry-on	Checked
Small cylinders fitted into a life-jacket up to 2 in life vests and 2 spares	✓	✓
Small non-flammable gas cylinders up to 4 and each must not exceed 50 mL	✓	✓
Compressed gas cylinders	✗	✗
Bleach	✗	✗
Spray paint	✗	✗
Ribbon spray	✗	✗
Electro shock weapons	✗	✗
Dry ice not exceeding 2.5 kg to pack perishables	✓	✓

Taking into account the requirements of individual countries (including the destination and transit countries), airlines may impose additional restrictions on items that passengers may carry onboard aircraft.
