Airworthiness Notices, which have been amended or newly introduced as of Issue 84, dated 30 November 2011, are:

As of Airworthiness Notice Issue No. 62 dated 30 May 2004, all newly issued or amended Notices (including Appendices) are printed on white papers only and the colour coding of Notices (and Appendices) as prescribed in Airworthiness Notice No. 1 has ceased effect at the same time. All Notices (and Appendices) are demarcated into two kinds: mandatory or non-mandatory. For Notices (and Appendices) carrying mandatory requirements, the statement "This Notice Gives Details of a Mandatory Action" will appear on the title of the Notice. Notices (and Appendices) previously printed on colour papers will be replaced by white paper Notices (and Appendices) at the time they are amended.

As of Airworthiness Notice Issue No. 68 (dated 30 May 2006), hardcopy Airworthiness Notice amendments will no longer be available. Holders of hardcopy Hong Kong Airworthiness Notices should refer to CAD website for up-to-date Airworthiness Notices (See Airworthiness Notice No. 1 Issue 21 for details).

As of Airworthiness Notice Issue No. 78 dated 23 February 2009, Airworthiness Notices and/or Appendices marked with * constitute the Definitive List the compliance status of which are required to be declared for the purpose of issue or renewal of Certificate of Airworthiness. No Definitive List will further be issued to individual Hong Kong operators.
