- 1. The application must be made with a cover letter on the applicant's company letterhead with a unique reference number.
- 2. The completed application and supporting documents shall be emailed to the Flight Standards and Airworthiness Division (FSAD) of the CAD at <u>coarenew@cad.gov.hk</u>. All submission should be in PDF format.
- 3. Additional information may be required and further conditions may be imposed depending on the particular circumstances of the proposed operations.
- 4. Any application with incomplete submission of information and / or supporting documents may be rejected, or may cause delay of the application process.

#### 7. Fee Information

- 1. Applicable fees and charges must be settled in accordance with Cap. 448D Hong Kong Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations.
- 2. Statutory Fees are payable in Hong Kong Dollars. Payment should be made through wire transfer, by bank draft or cheque.
