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SECTION 2: Declarations

Declarations

- (1) The risk of the flight is classified as Low Risk in accordance with FAA Order 4040.26B. All necessary risk assessments have been undertaken and satisfied that all risks in respect of the flight have been mitigated to an acceptable level.
- (2) The flight is operated by a person approved by the Director-General in accordance with AN(HK)O Schedule 2, B Conditions, paragraph (3).

- (3) The flight will only be conducted in accordance with the B conditions for the purpose as specified in Section 1 (8).
- (4) The aircraft is marked in a manner approved by the Director-General in accordance with AN(HK)O Schedule 2, B Conditions, paragraph (4)(a) and complied with AN(HK)O Article 14, 15, 32, 35, 57 and 59 requirements as if it was registered in Hong Kong, even the aircraft is not registered in Hong Kong.
- (5) The flight shall carry such flight crew as may be necessary to ensure the safety of the aircraft, even the aircraft is not registered in Hong Kong.
- (6) The pilot in command of the aircraft is approved by the Director-General for the purposes of the condition(s) specified in his/her approval.

- (7) The aircraft does not carry any cargo or any persons other than the flight crew except persons described in AN(HK)O, Schedule 2, B Conditions, paragraph (7)(a) to (f).
- (8) The aircraft does not fly over any congested area of a city, town or settlement except in accordance with procedures which have been approved by the Director-General in relation to that flight.
- (9) The defined design standard of the aircraft complies with the requirements and standards agreed with the Director-General and specified in Section 1(10).
- (10) The necessary maintenance actions have been completed and the aircraft is fit for flight under AN(HK)O, B Conditions.

Note 1: A certification statement has to be made in the aircraft technical log to certify that the necessary maintenance actions have been completed and the aircraft is fit for flights under AN(HK)O B Conditions by a qualified certifier.

- (11) The Flight Crew (and ground observers) understood and accepted the test plan and limitations for the flight. A pre-flight briefing has been carried out by the pilot in command before the flight commence. The aircraft was correctly loaded (weight, center of gravity and sufficient fuel).
- (12) The flight test schedule, flight procedures or test plan referenced in section 1(11) is appropriate for the purpose of the flight. The aircraft is in conformance with the defined design standard.
