Guidance Notes for Application for Permission for Carriage of Dangerous Goods in Aircraft

- Note 1:* The completed form together with all supporting documents should be submitted by post to the Dangerous Goods Office, Civil Aviation Department Headquarters, 1 Tung Fai Road, Hong Kong International Airport, Lantau, Hong Kong; by email to dgo@cad.gov.hk; or by fax to (852) 2795 8469. For enquiries, please call Tel. no.: (852) 2910 6981 / 2910 6982 / 2910 6986.
- Note 2:* The application form and all supporting document(s) should reach the Dangerous Goods Office at least 11 clear working days prior to the first flight for which the permission is required.
- Note 3:* For operators of Hong Kong registered aircraft, upon a satisfactory demonstration of compliance with all the requirements which included the satisfactory completion of an audit conducted by CAD, the permission will be issued within 11 clear working days. To ensure sufficient time for the audit, the operator is hereby reminded to submit the application not less than 2 months prior to the target date of operation for which the permission is required.
- Note 4:* An application fee of HK\$8,110 is payable at the submission of the application. Payment may be made by one of the following methods.
