Anyone, while having dealings of any kind with the Civil Aviation Department (CAD), should not offer advantage to the CAD officers, or else he may commit an offence under section 4(1) and/or section 8 of the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance (Chapter 201 of Laws of Hong Kong), and be liable to a maximum penalty of a fine of \$500,000 and imprisonment for 7 years.

Guidance Notes for Application for Permission for Carriage of Munitions of War in Aircraft

- Note 1: The completed form together with all supporting documents should be submitted by email to dgo@cad.gov.hk. Alternatively, applications may be submitted by fax to (852) 2795 8469; or by post to the Dangerous Goods Office, Civil Aviation Department Headquarters, 1 Tung Fai Road, Hong Kong International Airport, Lantau, Hong Kong. For enquiries, please call Tel. no.: (852) 2910 6856 / 2910 6857 / 2910 6855.
- Note 2: The application form and all supporting document(s) should reach the Dangerous Goods Office at least 11 clear working days prior to the first flight for which the permission is required. For the avoidance of doubt, the 11 working days is counted after the submission of all supporting document(s) required by the CAD during the application process.
- Note 3: Application for permission to carry MUW for a specified period of time must include the following:
- i) The procedures adopted by the operator to inform the pilot in command of the aircraft in writing before the flight commences of the type, weight or quantity and location of the MUW on board or suspended beneath the aircraft;
 - ii) The procedures adopted by the operator to ensure that the MUW is stored in part of the aircraft that is inaccessible to passengers;
 - iii) The procedures adopted by the operator to ensure that in case of a firearm, the weapon or MUW is unloaded; and
 - iv) The procedures adopted by the operator to ensure that securely packaged cartridges of ammunition classified as dangerous goods Division 1.4S (UN 0012 or UN 0014 only) are in quantities not more than 5 kg gross mass per person for that person's own use. They must not include ammunition with explosive or incendiary projectiles. Allowances for more than one person must not be combined into one or more packages.
- Note 4: Application for permission to carry a single consignment of MUW must include the following:
- i) The air waybill for the shipment;
 - ii) Shipper's Declaration for Dangerous Goods if the MUW consigned for shipment is classified as dangerous goods;
 - iii) The procedures or written confirmation of the operator to ensure that all relevant requirements as set out in Guidance Note 3 i) to iii) above are to be complied with; and
 - vi) Any other relevant documents relating to the MUW, including but not limited to licences to export MUW from the origin and to import MUW to Hong Kong, end user certificate / statement, shipping invoice and packing

list of MUW, etc.

Note 5: The application fee is payable at the submission of the application. Payment may be made by one of the following methods.
