

Declaration of Compliance
for Flights Operated for Hire or Reward to/from Hong Kong, China

Note: Operators shall note that this Declaration Form is only for use in urgent, exceptional and unforeseen situations and shall follow the procedures below for completing the Declaration Form:

- (1) Except for medical evacuation flights, humanitarian flights or flights for the purpose of life saving, search and rescue, operators shall ensure full compliance with the slot request requirements and procedures as per Slot Coordination Guidelines at Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) (available at : https://www.hkgslot.gov.hk/Useful_Info.html).
- (2) Operators shall submit a flight application along with all necessary documents to the Air Services and Safety Management Division (ASMD), Hong Kong Civil Aviation Department (CAD), by e-filing at https://www.cad.gov.hk/english/efiling_home.html before submitting this Declaration Form and state the relevant e-filing reference application number in the appropriate field below. Operators who are unable to access their e-filing accounts shall contact the System Administrator at asd@cad.gov.hk for reactivation of their accounts and state the username in the appropriate field below.
- (3) Except for the flights mentioned in (1) above, Declaration Form submitted by new or infrequent operators or operators who do not have an Accepted Aerodrome Operating Minima (AOM) issued by the CAD for the corresponding aircraft type of the concerned flights will **not** be accepted. These operators shall refer to section GEN 1.2 of the AIP Hong Kong and follow the flight application procedures stated therein as appropriate.
- (4) Operators shall complete the Declaration Form and submit it to CAD by email to aic@cad.gov.hk **and** asdoo@cad.gov.hk, or by fax to +852 2910 1180 **and** +852 2877 8542, **and** then call +852 2910 6174 to confirm receipt of this Form.

- d) this form can only be used in urgent, exceptional and unforeseen situations. The submitted information will be used for record and monitoring purposes. Any mis-use of these procedures or operations found not meeting all necessary requirements pertaining to the concerned flights may result in regulatory actions; and
- e) it is the obligation of the operator to ensure that slot(s) is / are available before making this declaration.

Anyone, while having dealings of any kind with the CAD, should not offer advantage to the CAD officers, or else he may commit an offence under section 4(1) and/or section 8 of the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance (Chapter 201 of Laws of Hong Kong), and be liable to a maximum penalty of a fine of \$500,000 and imprisonment for 7 years.

Operators shall ensure that all information given in applications and documents provided in support of this application are true to the best of their knowledge and belief. It is an offence under the law in Hong Kong if any declaration of information provided in this application and/or relevant supporting document applications is false.
