SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT ORDER

DESIGNATION OF RESTRICTED FLYING ZONE NOTICE

(Made under section 19(3) of the Small Unmanned Aircraft Order (Chapter 448G))

By virtue of the authority under section 19(3) of the Small Unmanned Aircraft Order, Chapter 448G, I hereby designate Sha Tau Kok Frontier Closed Area (including the airspace above the area) as a restricted flying zone for the purposes of section 18(1) of the said Order, to come into effect on 1 January 2024, and to have effect at all times during the day.

Please refer to G.N. 4994 published on 9 September 2022 for the restricted flying zones designated by virtue of section 19(3) of the Order and currently in force during all day.

Pursuant to section 19 of the Order, the Director-General of Civil Aviation, the Commissioner of Police, and the Secretary for Security may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, designate an area in Hong Kong (including the airspace above the area) as a restricted flying zone for the purposes of section 18(1) of the Order. Furthermore, relevant officials may publish a notice in the Electronic Portal for Small Unmanned Aircraft ('eSUA'), the designated information system, if the officials consider that it is necessary to publish the notice as soon as practicable, and that it is impracticable in the circumstances to publish the notice in the *Gazette*.

The above-mentioned restricted flying zone is shown as indexed, *inter alia*, on the Drone Map deposited in the library at the Civil Aviation Department Headquarters, 1 Tung Fai Road, Hong Kong International Airport, Lantau, Hong Kong. Members of the public may also refer to the Drone Map on eSUA (https://esua.cad.gov.hk/web/) for all restricted flying zones designated by virtue of section 19 of the Order.
