



Pilot Training

HKIAA Cadet Pilot Programme

- → A self-financed Cadet Pilot Programme
- → 14 months (Theory: 6 Months + Flying training: 8 months)
- > To facilitate airlines (which do not have its own cadet pilot programme) to recruit cadet pilots
- → 1st cohort started on 27 Nov 2023, target to train more than 500 cadet pilots in the next 5 years









ATC Training

Upgrade of ATC Simulator Training System

- Reproduce true-to-live ATC scenarios
- Allow joint simulation training for the entire towerapproach-area control process
- Can be programmed to replicate different training locations and map sectors

Programmes

- Controller Refresher Training
- Apron / Ground Movement Control Training
- Aerodrome Controller Training

- 220 controllers trained






