Dangerous Goods Advisory Circular DGAC 2/2025

Timely Reporting of Dangerous Goods Occurrence

In the interest of flight safety, dangerous goods (DG) occurrences must be reported to the relevant authorities without delay. Timely reporting of such occurrence is crucial to facilitate the collection of time-sensitive evidence, support effective investigation and enable swift follow-up actions with concerned parties to prevent recurrence.

- 2. The Civil Aviation Department (CAD) has recently noticed instances where DG occurrences were reported late. Such delays pose challenges to the investigation process and are not conducive to flight safety.
- 3. In the event a full report of the occurrence cannot be submitted immediately, operators are advised to submit an initial report containing all currently available information in the first place. For details of the reporting requirements, please refer to the Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC) 03/25.
- 4. Operators are encouraged to use the Dangerous Goods Occurrence Report Form (CAD Form DGO 6), which is available on the CAD website:-
