Dangerous Goods Advisory Circular DGAC 2/2026

Lithium battery power banks carried by passengers

To address the emerging risks to aviation safety posed by lithium battery power banks (“power banks”), the International Civil Aviation Organization (“ICAO”) has recently announced new requirements pertaining to power banks carried by passengers. The quantity allowed to be carried is limited to **two power banks per passenger**, and **passengers are prohibited from recharging power banks during flights**.

2. Effective immediately, for all flights departing from the Hong Kong International Airport, each passenger is allowed to carry no more than two power banks, which must be carried in carry-on baggage only. Recharging power banks is also prohibited during flights. Airlines and passenger handling staff are reminded to communicate effectively with passengers on the latest requirements.
