



Dangerous Goods Advisory Circular DGAC 3/2004

Steel Drums with UN Marking UN1A1/X1.3/250/04/CN/330710

Further to the Dangerous Goods Advisory Circular DGAC 1/2004 issued on 21 June 2004, investigation into the dangerous goods (DG) incident revealed that the UN steel drums used were sub-standard products and they did not meet UN specification requirements.

This Dangerous Goods Office is concerned with the aviation safety implication on the use of such sub-standard UN steel drums. Operators are hereby reminded not to accept any of these sub-standard drums with UN marking **UN1A1/X1.3/250/04/CN/330710** for carrying any kind of DG for air transport.
